

Clean Workplace Project

○ Purpose

- Reducing occupational accident by creating a "safe and healthy workplace" with subsidiary support for the establishment of a safety and health management system at high-risk workplaces with less than 50 full-time workers or less due to poor technical and financial capabilities for occupational accidents prevention

○ Legal foundation for the project

- Article 158 of Occupational Safety and Health Act (Subsidizing and Supporting Industrial Accident Prevention Projects)

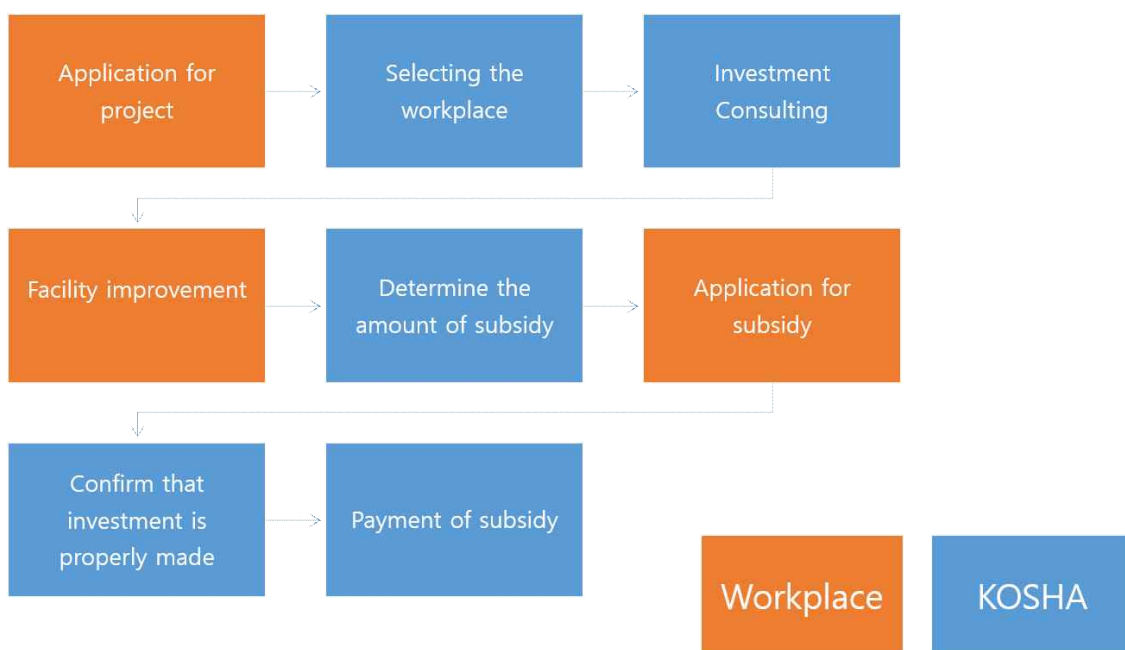

○ Priority support selection criteria

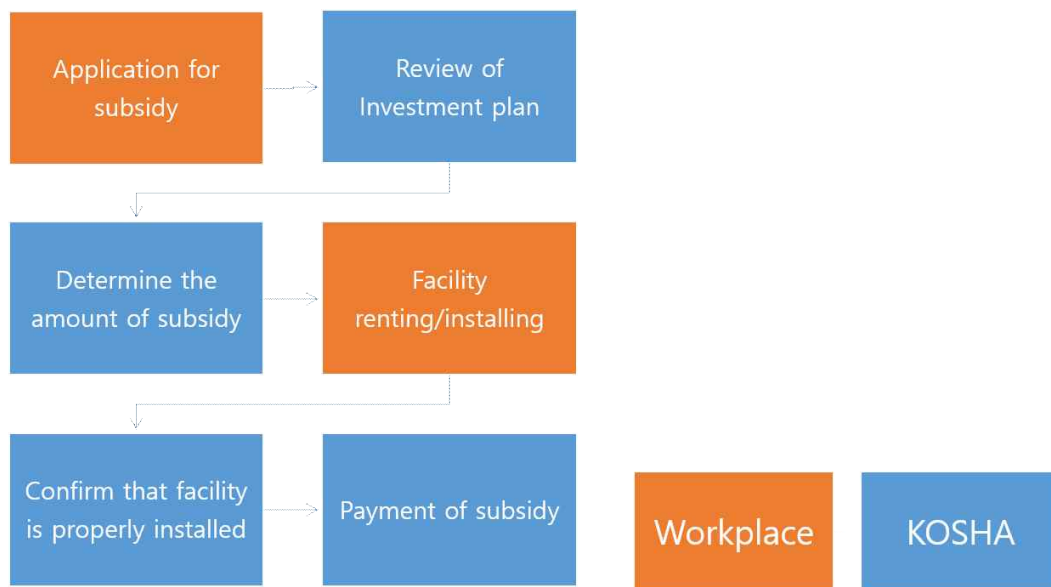
- Selected in consideration of accident prevention performance, such as whether or not to participate in risk assessment among business sites applying for participation in clean projects, the importance of each technology guidance project, and dangerous business types
- For the criteria for selecting priority support for each region, refer to the website of each regional/area offices of KOSHA

○ Process for Clean Workplace Accreditation

- Manufacturing/Service industries



- Construction industries



○ Accreditation period

- Re-recognition of clean workplace

- More than 3 years from the date of subsidy: Apply for additional subsidies within the limit of remaining subsidy per business
- More than 10 years from the date of application: Request for re-recognition, reset the remaining limit per business site (however, if it is reset, it cannot take precedence over the workplace who apply initially)
